

LAB TEAM ROLES

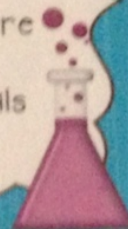
Technician

- ~ measures accurately
- ~ makes sure everyone is recording data, diagrams, and observations



Materials Manager

- ~ sets up materials before beginning the activity
- ~ makes sure all materials are cleaned up



Director

- ~ reads directions aloud for the group
- ~ keeps group on task and following directions



Facilitator

- ~ helps to decide who will do each part of the activity
- ~ makes sure group is quiet
- ~ keeps track of time

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LAB TEAM ROLES

Lab Team Roles are a great way to help your students stay engaged and work cooperatively during a lab activity. I know without roles, I've seen some very interesting behavior. 😊

Included are a poster of roles, a poster for each of the 5 roles, and individual student cards.

RECOMMENDATIONS

I recommend lab teams of 4 students or fewer. Sometimes there may be a need for a team of 5. In that case, you can use the participant card.

I recommend hole punching the student cards and putting yarn through them so students can wear them like a necklace.
